BRILLIANT Bulgarian drama in which a teacher tries to punish a thief, only to be dragged into her own moral quagmire. It's the complexity of central character Nadezhda (Margita Gosheva, superb) that makes the film so gripping: she's methodical but also irrational. Nadazhda's long week of the soul is full of black comedy. Like the Romanian classic, 4 Months, 3 Weeks and 2 Days, The Lesson is both harrowing and weirdly uplifting. British directors aiming for accessible realism should take note.
